Your financial aid will be posted against your Brown charges. It is your responsibility to pay any balances due to Brown and/or your abroad program. If you anticipate a credit balance, you will need to complete a Refund Request Form online with Student Financial Services (SFS) to receive the refund. **Please note that refunds for your semester abroad cannot be processed until your classes abroad have begun.**

If there is any concern about covering upfront expenses, such as airfare, visa, and/or deposit for your semester(s) abroad, or if the cost of your program will be higher than the semester(s) at Brown, and you would like to borrow loans, you should contact the Office of Financial Aid as soon as possible. We recommend speaking with a Financial Aid Counselor prior to the end of the previous term to discuss all available loan options.

Note that you will be unable to work while abroad, so should take that into consideration when determining the funds you may need.
